

GIANT ELEPHANT EAR

Alocasia

SUN LEVEL

• Dappled Shade-Partial Sun

CARE TIPS

- Keep soil moist at all times.
- Prefers acid soil, will benefit from periodic application of plant food for acid-loving plants (such as Miracid or Hollytone)

WHY WE LOVE IT

The elephant ear's giant bright green leaves are a bold statement in a shaded space. Underplanted with coleus or other shade-loving annuals, it will grow quickly in the summer heat.

Energize a shaded terrace or place in the garden among the shade plants for a pop for drama. These plants are pre-grown to a large size in south Florida for instant gratification!

PATIO PALM

CARE TIPS

- Keep soil moist at all times.
- Prefers acid soil, will benefit from periodic application of plant food for acid-loving plants (such as Miracid or Hollytone)

WHY WE LOVE IT

The areca palm is a classic summer look. Its sturdy and fast growing fronds are easy to care for and pair beautifully with clusters of bright flowering annuals.

Try clustering it with pots of hibiscus to create a lush tropicalterrace vignette.

Unlike palms that we use indoors, these plants are sun-grown and ready to go outside for the summer!

- Remove blooms as they expire. More will be on the way!

WHY WE LOVE IT

Gardenias have a heavenly scent! Their large pure white blooms and beautiful dark green waxy leaves are a striking addition to the summer garden.

• Partial to Full Sun

CARE TIPS

Succulents prefer to go rather dry in between waterings

WHY WE LOVE IT

Grown in a rainbow of colors, shapes, and sizes, succulents are fun to combine in to eye-catching arrangements. They are also easy to care for and really say 'summer'.

Bowls are available in 2 sizes (in a choice of 3 colors), both pre-planted and ready to display on a bright table or patio.

No two bowls are the same, but each one is bursting with interesting textures and color.

STAR JASMINE

Trachelospermum jasminoides

- Remove blooms as they expire. More will be on the way!

WHY WE LOVE IT

Star jasmine have a spectacular scent. When the jasmines are blooming in our conservatory, we can't get enough of them! This fine curling vine will vigorously climb a trellis or post, or stand alone in a decorative container with an obelisk.

EUGENIA TOPIARIES

Eugenia globulus

Sun/Partial Sun

CARE TIPS

- Keep soil moist at all times.
- Prefers acid soil, will benefit from periodic application of plant food for acid-loving plants (such as Miracid or Hollytone)
- Trim periodically to maintain topiary form.

WHY WE LOVE IT

Eugenias are dense and fast growing, ideal for topiary shaping. Their deep green leaves and clean trimmed lines make a handsome statement flanking an entrance or as a summer garden accent.

MANDEVILLA

Mandevilla sanderi

- Prefers acid soil, will benefit from periodic application of plant food for acid-loving plants (such as Miracid or Hollytone)
- Remove blooms as they expire. More will be on the way!
- Trim periodically to keep a tighter form, or allow vines to grow naturally.

WHY WE LOVE IT

Mandevilla vines bring a bounty of tropical flowers all summer long! Available in 3 colors, as tall narrow towers or as shorter staked vines, the mandevilla will vigorously climb a trellis or post, or stand alone in a decorative container with an obelisk.

HIBISCUS

Hibiscus rosa-sinensis

- Prefers acid soil, will benefit from periodic application of plant food for acid-loving plants (such as Miracid or Hollytone)
- Remove blooms as they expire. More will be on the way!



Thriving in summer's heat, the hibiscus is the most iconic tropical flower. Its large blooms keep coming all season and contrast beautifully against its deep green leaves.

Available in a tree form or as a round bush, this plant loves the sunshine of a rooftop or bright patio.
